RE: BLUE MOUNDS STATE PARK MASTER PLAN –

The DNR has announced they are initiating the planning process for the Blue Mound State Park Master Plan Revision. It will begin with scoping process that will ask what needs to be considered in the new Plan. The result of this process will be a master plan that replaces the existing 1984 master plan.

The public can learn more and engage in the planning process by attending the public meeting from 5-7:30 p.m., March 12, at the Mount Horeb Middle School Cafeteria, 900 E Garfield Street; Mount Horeb. The Department staff will provide a brief presentation at 5:15 p.m. followed by small group discussions to share perspectives and identify topics to be considered during the planning process.

This survey provides an opportunity to support a snowmobile connector trail from the Military Ridge State Trail to the regional trail network on private lands north of the park. Snowmobilers currently use the Mound Park Road right-of-way for this connection and we are asking for a safer, more enjoyable trail through the Park.
