Safety- snowmobile storage- keeping away the rodents . . .

Moth ball safety- if you are tempted to use moth balls to keep away pesky rodents please consider what you purchase and be sure to read the package insert. Moth balls contain a toxic chemical - either naphthalene or paradichlorobenzene- both which become a gas when exposed to air. When you smell moth balls you are inhaling the insecticide. These gases are irritants to the eyes and lungs. They are known to cause headaches, dizziness, nausea. Both can cause more harmful problems such as blood disorders and cancer. These should not be used in an area where humans can inhale the fumes (closed spaces, garages, attics, closets). Children have often mistaken the moth balls for candy causing serious illness. Use with caution.
